

Pastor's Perspective

"They devoted themselves to the Apostles teaching..." ~ Acts 2:42

As January gives way to February we also begin a new session of Wednesday Night Live. Every session is a new opportunity to jump into a new study or to serve. For the past several years I have alternated between teaching a class. attending a class and serving in the Children's Ministry (usually in the sound booth). Regardless of what I am doing for Wednesday Night Live, I have always made small group Bible study a priority. In addition to Sunday School, I feel it's important to meet with a group of guys whether I'm leading the group or just participating. There is something valuable that only happens in the context of a small group. I can study the Bible on my own and learn a lot, but I can't connect with other people and learn from their insights apart from a small group. This session of Wednesday Night Live we are offering several options for people. Seth and Denise will teach a marriage study, Steve Struble will lead a class through John MacArthur's teaching on the Parables, Kady

Hofer is leading a study on Titus, Aaron Struble will continue the men's class at the Y that is part Bible study and part weight-lifting, and I'll be teaching a class for men on the book of 1 Corinthians. Last session I met with a group of about 12 guys last year as we studied "Disciplines of a Godly Man" by Kent Hughes, and the Book of James. I'm excited as we regroup to dig into 1 Corinthians.

I write this to encourage you to consider getting involved in a small group. There are always many options to choose from. Dietrich Bonhoffer wrote: "Christian brotherhood is not an ideal which we must realize; it is rather a reality created by God in Christ in which we may participate." As we seek spiritual growth and maturity, it is never enough to dive into study and prayer in isolation. We benefit greatly by learning and growing together. There is another aspect of this that I think we often hesitate to be honest about. Participating in a group forces us to apply grace. Life in relationship is messy. We will hear things we don't agree with and we will most likely say or do something that offends someone else. Commitment to participate at a deeper level will mean working on issues of forgiveness and restoration. In the end it's a powerful exercise. We not only learn the truths of Scripture, but we actively see them at work as we grow in a small group. If you've been thinking about what you need to go the next step in your faith, this may be it. No matter where you are in your walk with the Lord, small group Bible study is always a good thing. In Christ, Pastor Luke



Mercer County Better Together Night In A Car Event



Night in a Car is a homelessness simulation intended to shine a spotlight on the hidden aspect of rural homelessness that many in our community experience – living in a car. Participants of Night in a Car will "live" out of their cars during the overnight hours of February 7th, 2025. Our challenge to participants is to raise \$500 per car. This can be done by seeking sponsors. Sponsors can be businesses, individuals, or organizations who make a commitment to donate a chosen amount of money to the Mercer County Emergency Housing Fund when their sponsored party spends the night in their car during the event.

The overnight simulation will be done "drive-in" style at three convenient locations throughout the county. Each location will have security volunteers throughout the night as well as a dedicated building open to participants for bathroom breaks, or to warm up with hot cocoa.
